- 2. A Rioja Alavesa red wine with barrel ageing.
- 3. A Rioja Oriental red wine with barrel ageing.

Do you think the characteristics of the following wines match those described in Module 2? Write three characteristics that you would highlight about each one. They will help you remember the variety.

- 4. Single-varietal Viura with no barrel-ageing
- 5. Single-varietal Viura with barrel-ageing If possible, with some years in the bottle.
- 6. Viura-Malvasía blend
- 7. Tempranillo Blanco
- 8. Single-varietal Tempranillo
- 9. Single-varietal Garnatxa
- 10. Single-varietal Graciano



Look at the oak-fruit balance and for the appearance of tertiary aromas that are associated with the evolution in the bottle (leather, dried fruit, coffee, wet earth, etc.). Also look at the amount of tannin and its characteristics. We recommend that, if possible, the following wines should come from the same winery.
